 Class 9. One vase, one stem, multi-headed.
 Class 10. One vase, three stems, multi-headed.
 Class 11. One vase, six stems, mixed.
 Class 12. One vase, one stem, tulip.
 Class 13. One vase, three stems, tulips mixed.
 Class 14. One pot/container growing tulips.

SECTION 3 GENERAL SPRING FLOWERS & POT PLANTS
 Class 15. Pot of growing Polyanthus (up to 5" pot).
 Class 16. One vase, three stems, Polyanthus.
 Class 17. One vase, five stems, Muscari (Grape Hyacinth).
 Class 18. One vase, one stem, Camelia.
 Class 19. One vase, six stems, any other flowers.
 Class 20. One vase, mixed Spring flowers.
 Class 21. One hanging pot (6" to 8" diameter).
